## About the IBS Institutional Scholarship

Members of the Buddhist Churches of America, the Jodo Shinshu Hongwanji-ha, other organizations, and individual donors have generously raised funds in support of Buddhist ministerial, academic, and chaplaincy education. Institutional aid generally refers to scholarships and other awards that do not need to be repaid by the student. Any regular degree or certificate program student of IBS is eligible to apply for these awards. (Auditors, special students, and exchange students are not eligible.)

## How to Apply for Scholarships and Loans

All degree and certificate program students who wish to apply for the IBS institutional scholarship must submit this application form directly to the IBS Office of the Registrar by the deadline of April 1, 2022 for the fall and spring semesters of the 2022/23 Academic Year. Students entering in the second half of the academic year, or spring term, must apply by November 1, 2022. IBS and GTU/IBS students may apply for IBS Institutional Scholarships. GTU/IBS common MA students are may also contact the GTU Financial Aid Office for information on additional sources of funding, available through the GTU. This application is solely for the purpose of applying for the IBS Institutional Scholarship. The scholarship must be renewed annually by submitting a new application form.
