* The Master of Buddhist Studies (M.B.S.) program is designed to be completed in two (2) years of full-time (12 units per semester) coursework, or the equivalent of 48 units. Students are not required to enroll full time; however, the cost of the program may increase over time for student who enroll part-time.

"Number of Students Who Began the Program" means the number of students who began a program who were scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year and excludes all students who cancelled during the cancellation period.

"Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began the program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.

"Number of On-time Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year.

"On-time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduates divided by the number of students available for graduation.
