# Buddhist Japanese IV: HR-3061

Course Level: Advanced Instructor: Kurioka

Students will be required to read extended text selections in Japanese. This course introduces advanced Japanese grammar. Discourse level grammar and sentence analysis will be studied in depth. Students will continue to build upon knowledge of Buddhist terminology and *kanji*.
